As an owner/operator of a Model 300 Helicopter, you will find that there are many service publications available to help you service, maintain, repair, and otherwise keep your aircraft in optimum operating condition and thus minimize down time.


With the delivery of each new helicopter for example, Schweizer provides a data package including a Pilot's Flight Manual, Handbook of Maintenance Instructions, Illustrated Parts Catalog, Service Information Notices and Letters, and a Log Book. The original owner also receives a complimentary one year subscription service for new issues and revisions to the above publications. Secondary publications, such as Price Lists, Kit Installation Instructions, Lubrication and Inspection Check Sheets, are also available through Schweizer Product Support. To maintain the subscription service, owners/operators must renew the subscription each year, with a reduced renewal fee applicable after the first paid subscription.
